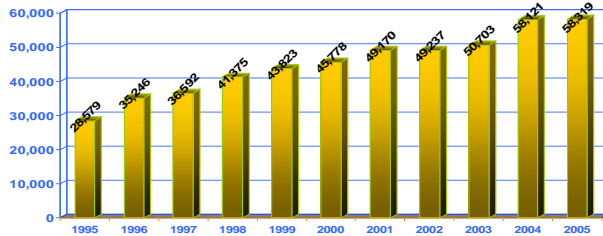

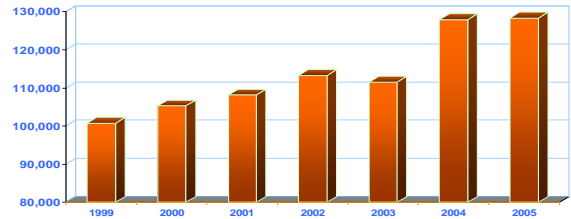
Cases Registered in last 10 years under Section 498A IPC



Number of cases have increased by more than 100% in 10 years

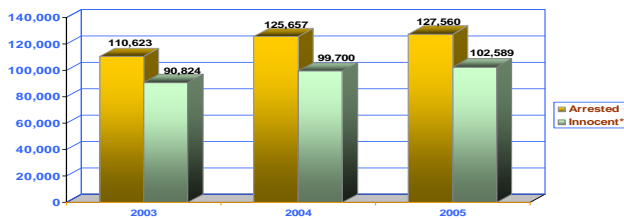

People Innocent Vs. People Arrested under Section 498A IPC

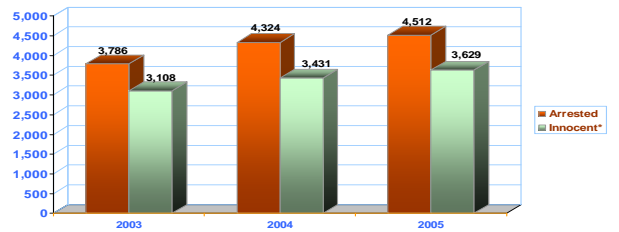


One INNOCENT Person is Arrested Every 5 minutes

Elder Abuse - Senior Citizens Arrested under Section 498A IPC

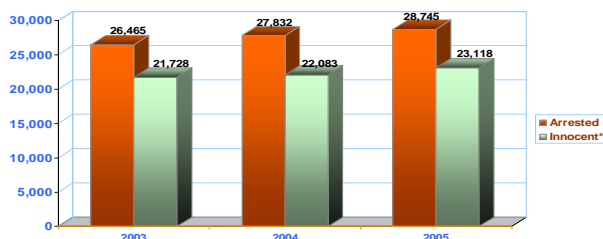


One INNOCENT Elderly is Arrested Every 2.4 hours

Women Abuse - Women Arrested under Section 498A IPC

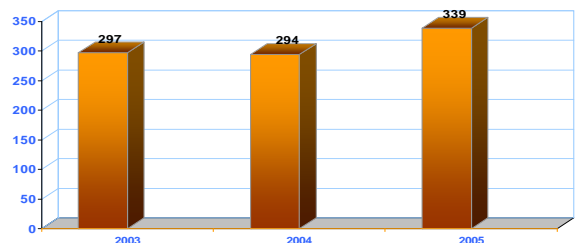


One INNOCENT Woman is Arrested Every 23 minutes

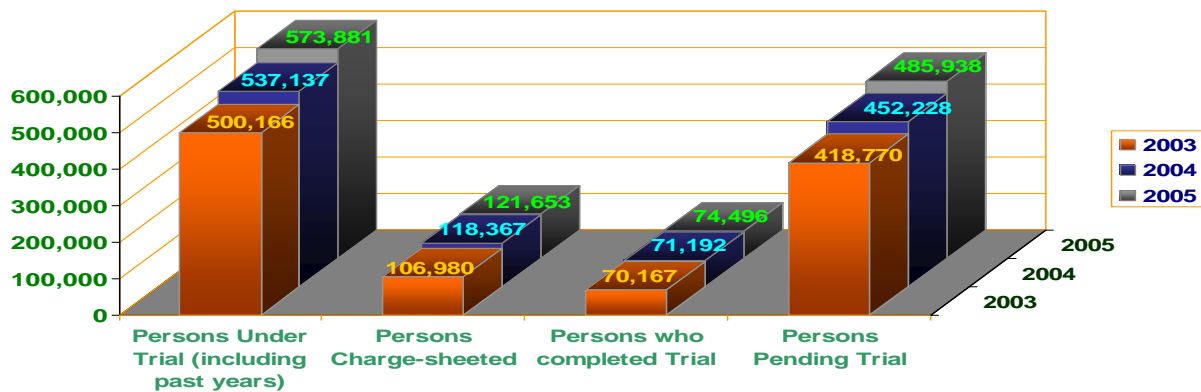


One Minor is Arrested almost Every Day

498A - Impact on Judiciary

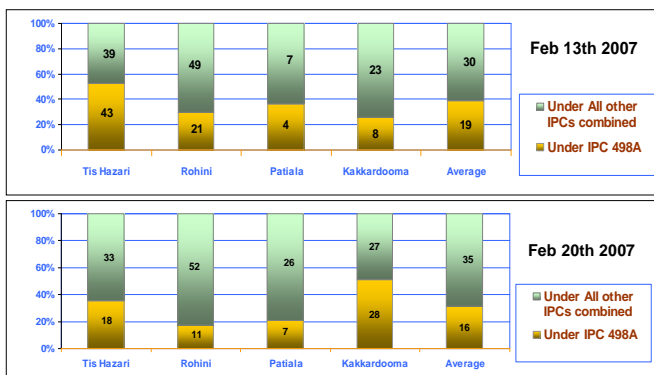
Burden on Judiciary for Section 498A IPC

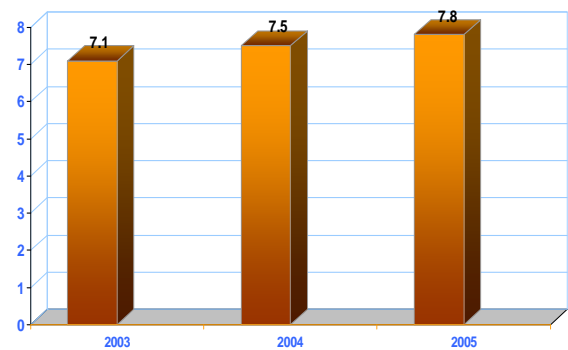
Bail Applications in Delhi Courts
